We are pleased to announce that the second NECLIME meeting in Asia will be held in Nanjing, China, from May 27 to 29, 2012. The organizing committee cordially invites you to participate in this symposium and to contribute your newly developed knowledge for the NECLIME research.

With the incessant progress of the NECLIME research, it is now well recognized that some enhanced exchanges among colleagues in Asia and other parts of the world have become increasingly important. We can thus broaden the fields of our studies, and more importantly, attract new colleagues to join the NECLIME network.

Scientific Program

- ◆ Palaeoclimate and palaeoenvironmental evolution in the Neogene of Eastern Eurasia, interactions between climate, biosphere, and palaeogeography.
- ◆ Variability and seasonality of precipitation, including monsoonal patterns and the aridification of Central Asia.
- ◆ Identification of palaeoaltitude from the palaeobotanical record.
- ◆ Palaeoclimate and vegetation modeling.
- ◆ Floristic exchange between Europe and Asia.
- ◆ Stratigraphical concepts for E Eurasia.
